

CULDROSE HAS ALL ROUTES COVERED FOR AIR DAY 2016

Traffic Management Plans will be in place to ease pressure on the road system around Royal Naval Air Station Culdrose during AIR DAY on THURSDAY 28 JULY.

Event starts at 0900 and closes at 1800.

Postcode for Sat Nav is TR12 7RH. Please ignore your Sat Nav as you approach the Air Station and follow the Air Day traffic signs. All directions to Air Day will be sign posted and will lead you to the quickest route for the appropriate car park.

Remember to make a note of which car park and entrance you are using.

We anticipate up to 10,000 vehicles attending the event. Please allow for some delay on entry and exit.

From Helston/Penzance. Access will be via Culdrose main gate on the A3083.

From Falmouth/Truro. Follow the traffic signs for Air Day along the A394, follow the Air Day signs and you will be diverted off the A394 via a temporary one way system through Gweek and into the site via W site gate.

From The Lizard. You will be directed to Culdrose Sports Pavilion fields. Follow the signs and traffic marshals will direct you.

Disabled Access. Disabled parking area will be available in 2 of the main car parks which you will be directed to where required, providing flat firm ground for ease of access. It may involve approximately 70m walk to the main site, however the whole site is predominately flat with tarmac access routes available. Please display Blue Badge prominently on arrival and you will be directed to suitable parking. Please avoid arriving before 0900 as the early bird car park is not suitable for disabled access.

Parking marshals will direct you to designated parking areas. Please make a note of which car park you are in to ease finding your car again at the end of the day. Once parked, you will be directed to the ticketing booths to purchase entry tickets. Although parking is free, by entering the site you are agreeing to the purchase of an Air Day ticket for each member of your party. Public are not permitted to remain in the parking areas without being in possession of a valid Air Day ticket.

Arriving by Local Bus Service. Please use [First Group Journey Planner](#) for bus times on day.

Arriving by Cycle or on Foot. Please use the cycle/ foot path on the A3083 and access the site on the same side of the road as the foot path.

On Departure. We request that you remain patient and follow the directions of the traffic marshals as we will have a large volume of vehicles to disperse safely and as quickly as possible for your convenience. Please exit the car parks as directed by the traffic marshals in an orderly fashion to prevent bottlenecks. These directions might not appear initially to be taking you in the direction that you want to go but traffic systems are in place to ease routes out to all destinations.
