IDT MTT - INTERNATIONAL REGULATIONS FOR PREVENTION OF COLLISIONS AT SEA (IRPCS)

AIM OF SUBJECT

The IRPCS state the rules to be adhered to by all vessels on the high seas regardless of type, organisation or location. It is important that all users have a good understanding and are able to implement as required. It is essential that maritime law enforcement professionals have a comprehensive understanding and can demonstrate a high level of knowledge and capability whilst at sea to other sea users. Maritime professionals will also require a thorough knowledge if having to deal with maritime collisions or incidents and the subsequent investigation.

OUTLINE SYLLABUS

No prior knowledge is required. The subject is all classroom based and works through the 5 parts and 4 Annexs of the IRPCS. The subject is taught through reading, power-point, examples and exercises.
