IDT MTT - GLOBAL MARITIME DISTRESS SAFETY SYSTEM (GMDSS)

AIM OF SUBJECT

GMDSS is an internationally agreed-upon set of safety procedures, types of equipment, and communication protocols used to increase safety and make it easier to rescue distressed ships, boats and aircraft. As a professional maritime organisation it is important that you have a good understanding of GMDSS, knowledge of how each part works and how to react effectively when utilised.

OUTLINE SYLLABUS

The subject is classroom based and describes all parts of the GMDSS system and its implementation within the worldwide maritime community, how the equipment operates, how vessels in distress should use them and how rescue organisation or craft should react when receiving distress information.
