I wanted to take this opportunity to update you on the Storybook Waves project and how Aggie's will continue to provide this service during Covid-19.

Aggie's Storybook Waves is a free service that enables serving personnel to record a bedtime story for their children to listen to whilst they are away. The facility is open to all across the fighting arms of the Naval Service who are apart from their children through deployment, courses, weekending or long shift patterns.

I know that a service such as Storybook Waves is even more important in the uncertain times that all families are currently facing and as such I am pleased to announce that serving personnel will now be able to use their smartphone to record stories.

Rather than meeting face to face with a Pastoral Worker in the chaplaincy we are inviting serving personnel who wish to access the service to email storybookwaves@aggies.org.uk. I will then email all the details that the person needs directly to them. At the end of the process, families will receive their special pack which will contain one of the books that has been read, a copy of the book 'Zoe and the Time Rabbit' which has been donated by the Naval Children's Fund, activity scrapbooks provided by the charity Reading Force and a mini medal to say Thank you to the children.
