JET SKIING IN THE CLYDE DOCKYARD PORT

1. Mariners are advised that, as per [QHM Clyde General Direction 12/22](#), otherwise than in accordance with a written permission granted by the Queen's Harbour Master, no water-skiing or jet-skiing is permitted within the Clyde Dockyard Port.
2. Ministry of Defence Police Clyde Marine Unit patrol the Gareloch, Loch Goil and Loch Long. Any jet skis found in these areas will be asked to leave the water and a fine may be issued, at the discretion of QHM Clyde and Ministry of Defence Police.
