MILITARY TRAINING IN THE VICINITY OF BROWNDOWN POINT: 19 TO 29 JULY 2021



· P3: 50°47.022'N 001°11.220'W

- 3. All vessels will display the correct day shapes and lights.
- 4. This training will involve marking temporary anchorages with buoys, diving operations and towing flexible barges

within 300m of Browndown Battery beach area.

- 5. Additionally, flexible barge towing training will also take place further out into the Eastern Solent to gain experience of towing the barge in varying depths and conditions.
